OBJECTIVES

The Overall Objective of the Project is to contribute to the reduction of road crashes, especially ones resulting in death or severe health injuries and socioeconomic damage.

The Specific Objective of the Project is to improve legal and institutional capacities and staff competences of lead and participating public agencies and other stakeholders to better manage, coordinate and address traffic safety issues in Azerbaijan.

MAIN ACTIVITIES

Strengthening of legal and institutional framework of road safety system

- Assessment of gaps and recommendations concerning the legislative acts in the field of road safety
- Relevant draft amendments to and/or new legislative acts and technical regulations
- Mapping and functional analysis of the transport sector institutions in charge for the road safety
- Potential scenarios for institutional transformations, including respective roles and responsibilities of the key institutions

Setting up an effective Road Safety Management System

- A Guidelines for Road Safety Management System with all necessary procedures
- Proposed new Road Accidents
 Prevention mechanism and a Smart
 Road Traffic Accidents Reduction
 Strategy based on Intelligent
 Transportation Systems (TARS)
- A new set on road safety performance indicators, including their descriptions and methodologies in line with EU indicators system
- Practical road safety inspections followed by report and set of recommendations
- Established single (no-cost)
 integrated database on traffic flows
 and accidents and proposed
 general architecture, objectives
 and structure of the database

Human resources development, education, advocacy and promotion in road safety

- Training programme and training packages with detailed curriculums for the employees for all target groups, approved by the head of the administration
- Countrywide traffic safety awareness-rising and communication strategy, including advocacy and promotion action plan prepared and in use
- Accident prevention and public education information campaign prepared, aiming at increasing road safety awareness among road users, especially vulnerable road users (children, elderly people, pedestrians, cyclists, motorcyclists)
- Established framework for provision of the road safety education in schools on a systematic and continuous basis
